- 1. We discussed how children felt about our new values. As a school we have now decided on the final nine values. These are:
  - Respect
  - Citizenship
  - Creativity
  - Perseverance
  - Courage
  - Independence
  - Team Work
  - Caring
  - Aspiration

All children across the school have been asked to complete a form with words and pictures of what they feel these words mean to them. These will then be used to create posters and badges for the school. At the next pupil leadership meeting, we will decide on the best pictures for our badges.

We looked at what the individual values cards will look like that will enable pupils to collect their values points.

We discussed SMSC (Social, Moral, Spiritual and cultural) and how we could make links to our values for each of these areas. Posters were created to show these links and these will be shared in a future assembly around our values.

- 2. We discussed attendance monitors and decided on which badges would be suitable for this role, we want to make sure that interviews will be held for children who are interested in becoming an attendance monitor. We decided that in order to be an attendance monitor, you have to be a good role model and be in school and on time to promote this to the other children. Mrs Broome will ask teachers after half term to talk to their class about being an attendance monitor and provide a list for the pupil leadership team of those children who are interested. It was decided that attendance monitors will be responsible for making sure that each class has their weekly attendance on their classroom door and will be responsible for the attendance trophy each week.
- 3. Mrs Broome introduced the idea of punctuality points as an incentive for being in school on time. We thought this was a great idea and thought this would be another responsibility for the attendance monitor to have. More information will be discussed at the next pupil leadership meeting.
- 4. We discussed and wrote up what being a member of the pupil leadership team meant and what we each bring to the group. These will be displayed on our pupil leadership board and on the school website.
