These will be kept in school at all times. The school will also take the responsibility for washing the kit regularly.</p>	<p>Children are able to access the entire lesson and do so with greater enjoyment through having appropriate kit. Children's overall approach to PE has become more positive as they feel they are valued more. Some children who forgot their kit regularly have started to bring their own as they do not want to borrow.</p> <p>Those who have been given their own set of kit were very appreciative and have appeared to gain greater self-esteem in lessons and now have a more positive experience due to them not standing out due to not having kit. Behavior of these children is noticeably better and those that were once PE refusers are now participating and accessing PE.</p>
