

ParentPay – our new online payment service

We are pleased to announce that from the 4th June 2018 we will be accepting payments online for dinner money, school trips and clubs. Using a secure website called ParentPay you will be able to pay online using your debit or credit card. For those who are unable to access online you will still be able to use cash at a local PayPoint store. ParentPay will be our preferred method of making payments to school. A pre-launch letter has been sent home with your child today which will hopefully answer some of your initial questions. Letters containing your personal login will be sent via post to the parent who is first contact. For those parents who require an additional account for their child will need to contact the office for an additional login.



It is really important to supervise your child whilst they are online and to talk to them about what they should do if they are unsure or unhappy about anything they encounter on the internet. Many social media apps like Snapchat, Instagram and WhatsApp have age limits - did you know





you must be 18 to have a YouTube account? The YouTube Kids app is a great way of making sure your child

isn't accessing adult content but you should still make sure that you are monitoring what they are watching as sometimes videos slip through the net.
