For Sports Days this year we would like all children to wear a T-Shirt in their house colour.



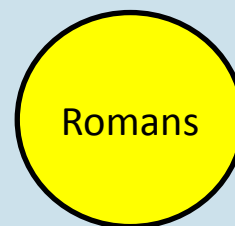
