Dear Families,

Welcome back to the last half term of the Summer. It is set to be packed full of events so please do take time to look at the school calendar in the newsletter.

The children have all come back ready for learning and preparations are well underway for their transition either from their pre-school or nursery, within school or up to their chosen Secondary School.

We have introduced a new House Point token system in school. The children now receive a token for their hard work and efforts whether for their conduct or learning or both! They have enjoyed popping the token in the corresponding tube ready for counting on a Thursday for our celebration on a Friday.

The Year 1 children will be taking their phonics test this next week. This is a Government statutory test. Throughout the week, Mrs Broome, Miss Shaw and the Year 1 team will be supporting them. Phonics is a method of learning to read words that is taught right from the start of Reception. Children are taught to read letters or groups of letters by saying the sound(s) they represent. Children can then start to read words by blending the sounds together to make a word. So it is important to help them read in the future. They have been practicing really hard and definitely looking out for those alien words!

On Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> June we will hold our 'move up' day for all the children and there will be the opportunity for you to pop back into class after that day to meet your child's new teacher and see their classroom.
