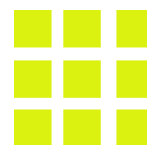
PE Days

EYFS Summer Term 1 2018 - Theme: Growing



Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Children will continue to form positive relationships with adults and other children and acceptable behaviour within the environment. Children will talk about their ideas and will continue to choose resources for their activity. They will continue to adjust their behaviour to different situations.

Communication and Language

Children will continue to listen in a range of situations, giving attention to what others say and respond appropriately. They will extend their ability to respond to stories by asking questions and predicting what might happen next, expressing themselves effectively.

Physical Development

We will continue to focus on forming our letters correctly in our daily handwriting sessions. Children will be using a range of tools safely and with control. We will be exploring the importance of exercise and what it does to our bodies as well as learning about coordination and multi-skills in PE.

English

Reading

We will be applying our phase 2 and 3 sounds to read simple words and sentences, decoding regular words and reading some common irregular words.

Writing

Children will be encouraged to use clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning representing sounds correctly and in sequence. They will also be attempting to write simple sentences that other can read.

Mathematics

Number

Children will develop their understanding of number through doubling, halving and sharing.

Shape, Space and Measure

Children will develop their understanding of times linked to days of the week and sequencing events. We will be exploring money, describing patterns and comparing quantities to solve problems.

Understanding of the World

People and Communities

Children will talk about past and present events in their own lives and celebrating how people are different.

The World

We will be exploring different plants and what they need to grow. We also look at life cycles of various animals.

Technology

We will be using simple programs on the computers to design castles for our giant.

Expressive arts and design

Exploring and Using Media and Materials

Children will be using a variety of resources to construct with. They will be taught how to use simple tools and techniques appropriately.

Being Imaginative

Children will be working together to develop and act out the stories learnt with their friends. They will be encouraged to create simple representations of events, people and objects.
