Dear Families,



SCHOOL DEVELOPMENT NEWS

Last Friday, I attended a conference in London on 'Moving a school from Good to Outstanding'. It was interesting to hear from other Headteachers and their experiences and it was great to reflect on the outstanding practice already established at Nine Acres. On Tuesday, Miss Fry, Mrs Scott, Mrs Shaw and Miss Bekesi travelled all the way to Leeds to attend the 'White Rose Mathematics' Conference. They heard from some very well known professionals in the Mathematics world and got all the national updates ready to share with the staff and children at Nine Acres. It wasn't just professional development for teachers though. On Thursday we held a 'Learning Support Development Day'. We try to ensure that the LSA team remain up to date with latest practice as they have a significant impact on the pupils both educationally and socially. On this day they reviewed the pupil passports for our pupils with special educational needs, designed transition booklets for the children who were feeling a little nervous about moving into their next year group and took the time to meet in teams to transfer up the wealth of information about pupils to their new LSA for next year.






