This term's exciting book!

Through the story of 'The Hummingbird' we will learn interesting facts about the species to create informative texts. We will be writing beautiful odes to the fantastic bird. They will even be jumping into the shoes of one of the main characters and writing a diary entry in their perspective. Our Maths this half term!

This half term we will be continuing to master our knowledge of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division within our Early Bird Maths.

Then we will look at 2D and 3 D shapes and identify their properties. They will be sorting and comparing the shapes also.

We will also be learning about how to find fractions of a shape, a group of objects and a number. We will be finding halves, quarters and thirds. This will be a big part of our learning this half term.
