

fear 4 Autumn Term 2 2018 Theme: Saxons and Vikings

English

Our text is The Wolves in the Walls. It's a dark, scary yet funny book with outstanding illustrations about predictions that come true. Children will learn to write a:

- Non chronological report about wolves
- Write a newspaper article about the events in the story
- Write a setting description to create suspense
- A story which is their own, but similar to our text in style

Mathematics

We will start with the basics of metric measurements and converting between them, which will lead on to measuring and calculating perimeters of rectangles and rectilinear shapes!

We will then move on to securing our multiplication and division facts by calculating mentally and applying that knowledge

to formal written methods.



<u>Science</u>

Our topic is sound! We will learn about how sound is created, and how the pitch and volume of sounds can be changed in a variety of ways. We will carry out experiments to find the answers to some thought provoking questions!

Religious Education

Children will learn about the concept of 'Holy'. They will : Describe the concept of holy,

describe how Christians show that they believe Mary is holy, evaluate the concept of holy by describing the value of Mary's holiness to believers, and describe their own response to the concept of holy.

Children will need their P.E kits on **Wednesdays and Fridays**.

Prepare to be invaded with enthusiasm and knowledge about the Saxons and Vikings! Children will carry out research about aspects of our ancestors - where they have come from, why they have come here, what lifestyle they have led and what legacy they have left behind for us and present these to the class. Children will secure and deepen their geography and
