Enrichment Clubs from September 2019

Due to the financial climate for schools it has now become necessary to charge all pupils for after school enrichment clubs. This means that those parents who qualify for free school meals will now be responsible for the costs of enrichment clubs if your child wishes to take part.

Our Autumn Term Enrichment Clubs will run for a 12 week block.

You will be notified by text message if your child has been allocated a place and all clubs require payment. These will be available to pay for on Parentpay.

All payments will need to be paid for by
Wednesday 11th September 2019.

Are you entitled to Free School Meals?

Are you in receipt of any of the following benefits?

- a) Income Support (IS)
- b) Income based Jobseeker's Allowance (IBJSA)
- c) Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA)
- d) Guaranteed Pension Credit
- e) Support under part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999
- f) Universal Credit
- g) Child Tax Credit, provided the parent is **not** entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income, as assessed by HMRC, which does not exceed £16,190
- h) Where a parent is entitled to Working Tax Credit **run-on** (the payment someone receives for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
