Dear Families of Nine Acres,

We are so proud of them and very impressed by their attitude to their learning. We are very much looking forward to seeing our Year 6 pupils on Monday 8th June. A huge THANK YOU to the staffing team who have gone over and above to support your children returning to school.

A reminder that we do have space for all of our EYFS, Year 1 and Year 6 pupils to return so please do call us if you have any questions or queries.

For those families whose children are still at home, new learning packs will be emailed to you on a weekly basis to support their learning at home. We are also happy to provide a paper version for collection from the office. Just give us a call if you would like this to give us time to get it copied for you. The first pack will be available from 15th June.

It is this time of year in which we organise the staffing team for the next year. I'm delighted that we have no vacancies at Nine Acres Primary and so we move forward with a very established and experienced staffing team to support your children. I will be able to share with you your child's class teacher in the next couple of weeks and we are looking at how we can support transition for all our pupils. From the 6th July your child will receive learning (either in school or at home depending) from their new class teacher as we move them up into their new year group. This will help us close any learning gaps before September as well as build on relationships between the new teacher and your child.

A reminder that the school will be closed to all pupils on Monday 15th June. This is for a planned development day in which the teaching team will liaise with each other about your child and their learning. They will look at your child's books, discuss friendships, strengths and areas of development as well as spend time planning for next steps so the move into the next year group is as smooth as possible meaning your child gets off to the very best start.

PLAY DOUGH

YOU'LL NEED:

- -1 cup flour -1/2 cup table salt

- -1 tbsp oil -1 cup boiling wate

INSTRUCTIONS:

1.In a bowl, combine the flour, salt and cream of tartar. Mix

- 2. Add the oil
- 5. Mix a few drops of food coloring into the boiling water and add to the bow
- 4. Mix everything very well and massage with your hand until it is
- no longer sticky.
- Once it has fully cooled, wrap in plastic and put in an airtight container. Store at room temperature for about 6 months.





YOU'LL NEED:

- -Shavina cream
- -Ziploc bag

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1.Add equal aparta glue and shaving cream in a bowl.
- 2. Add food coloring and mix well If you want to use the paint in a DIY piping bag:
- 1.Add the paint to a ziplock bag.
- 2.Close the bag and cut a small piece of corner off. 3. Squeeze the paint through the opening

Cookery Section - Fruit Pizzas

Ingredients

4 medium tortillas, whole wheat 1/2 cup Greek yogurt, plain 1 teaspoon honey 1/2 teaspoon vanilla extract

3/4 tablespoon orange juice

Toppings

1/4 cup strawberries 1/4 cup kiwi 1/4 cup mandarin oranges, canned in juice 1/4 cup blueberries 1/4 cup grapes, green

Instructions

Using a small cookie cutter or drinking glass, cut circles into tortillas. Set aside. In a small mixing bowl, blend together yogurt, honey, vanilla and orange juice until fully blended. Slice strawberries; peel kiwi and slice; drain oranges and slice into smaller pieces; slice blueberries and grapes into quarters.

Spread yogurt mixture onto tortillas and top with fruit.
