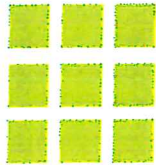
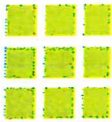


Our Values

We aim to provide opportunities for children to:

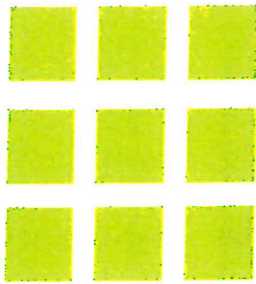
- Achieve academic excellence
