
Are you entitled to Free School Meals?

- a) Income Support (IS)
- b) Income based Jobseeker's Allowance (IBJSA)
- c) Income-Related Employment and Support Allowance (IRESA)
- d) Guaranteed Pension Credit
- e) Support under part VI of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999
- f) Universal Credit
- g) Child Tax Credit, provided the parent is not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income, as
- assessed by HMRC, which does not exceed £16,190
- h) Where a parent is entitled to Working Tax Credit **run-on** (the payment someone receives for a further four

weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)


If you are applying for a place at a Church Aided Primary School you might need to complete their Supplementary Information Form as well, and return the form direct to them – contact the school to find out.
