
Dear Families of Nine Acres Primary School,

Today has been a very special day for Island families as they find out their places for their children for Reception 2021! A big 'HELLO' to our new families who have chosen Nine Acres for their child! We can't wait to meet you all and welcome you to the Nine Acres unique family. A special letter is on its way to you so look out in the post.



We do still have a very few spaces left, as demand is high, so if you know anyone who wants to join Nine Acres for September 2021 Reception class please tell them to give us a call for a tour and get in quick!!

It has been wonderful to have our children return from their Easter Break. They have come back full of enthusiasm and we have been very impressed by their dedication to their learning. We are talking to the children in Year 1 to Year 6 about our new way of working with them when receiving feedback about learning from the teacher. Mrs Barbour and Miss Hancox are leading the changes with the staff and the children across the school. This will mean that the children will be expected to take more ownership of their learning and become more responsible in taking on board advice and acting upon it to improve their learning in Maths and English, at this stage. The children are already starting to engage and



being very grown up in talking about their education and what helps them to learn. Our highly skilled staffing team are modelling the changes and how to work with the new process so you may see some changes in your child's book and how they talk about learning at home.

It is Year 5 Parents' meetings next Wednesday. This will follow our process of a video call with your child's teacher and your child using 'School Cloud'. Feedback from our other year group families has been really positive so we look forward to 'seeing' our Year 5 families at this time. Miss Fry's class - Windsor appointments will also be on this day.

Thank you for supporting us with the children's uniform for Summer Term. We really do appreciate this in bringing the children together as a united Nine Acres team. Please can families try to ensure their child has the right PE uniform on their PE days. They should be wearing Nine Acres green T-shirts and hoodies (available at Kids and Co) and not their own hoodies from home. This brings them together as a sports team and is more appropriate wear for school. It makes them feel part of the school and this is an important value in our children belonging.



Year 3 Arundel Swimming Lessons

Year 3 swimming lessons have begun for Arundel Class. The children leave on the coach at 12.00pm. prompt. All children require a swimming costume/swim shorts, a pair of goggles, a named towel and a plastic bag for wet items. Children with verrucas will need to wear a verruca sock and children with long hair should have it tied up or wear a swimming cap. All children need a packed lunch and a healthy snack on swimming days. A water bottle is also required.

How can I access my child's teacher?

We ask that parents do not try to speak to the class teacher or LSA at the start or end of the day unless approached by



the staff member directly. This is to avoid community transmission. If you need to give your child's teacher a message, then please contact the office through text or email. Staff aim to respond as quickly as possible and will call you to discuss as needed.

In addition, only one adult, with a face covering, is permitted into the office area at any one time. Please maintain your distance from the hatch area and only pop in if essential. All other contact can be made by phone, email or text.


