
Thank you to everyone who attended our Summer Fair and joined in the fun! It seems such a long time ago we were able to do this. A big THANK YOU to the Helping Hands


We are back to school Monday 20th June. We know traffic may be an issue on this day so we do understand if they are a little late due to this but we do expect the children to be in school please!


Our Mental Health Mission Statement
