Our Mathematics this half term!

This half term, we are continuing our learning with multiplication and division. We will revisit the times tables focusing on the pattern between the 2, 4, and 8 times tables. We will learn new strategies to multiply and divide one and two-digit numbers, including grouping, sharing and grid method.
