Dear Families,


You will be aware that there have been a number of rising cases of COVID19 on the Island and in local Island Schools. I just wanted to take this time to share with you the protocol should the situation arise at Nine Acres Primary.



Firstly we are guided and led by Public Health England, the Local Authority along with the Department of Education. Should a child or staff member test positive then the first point of contact for us will be with Public Health England. They will assess the situation, including length of time the affected person has been in school and contacts since the symptoms developed and guide us in our next steps. This may include closing a class group for self-isolation for a period of time, asking the staff member/s to self-isolate for a period of time or no action required as the limited contact means the risk of transmission is low. We have already set up what the learning at home would look like should the children need to self-isolate as a result

of your feedback from previous situations and survey on technology at home. Please be assured that we will always act in the best interests of our community, aim to inform you of matters as practice ally as possible and I urge everyone to remain vigilant in the routines we have set out. Please support us by choosing not to speculate and add to rumours on any social media as an outlet. We want to work with you and there is always a bigger picture to any situation. Let's work together to **#stayopen**.

On a different note, it has been another successful week in school, with children enjoying their learning. Both myself and Mrs Broome have been overwhelmed by the amount of children choosing to do extra learning at home. This is all credit to you and your support thank you. You should have seen your child's Autumn Term 2 Curriculum Leaflet that they have brought home this week.


Parents' Evening
