
Mathematics

We will be continuing our addition learning this term, looking closely at number bonds to 10. We want to become number bonds champions and earn our badges. We will be moving onto subtraction of one-digit numbers using a range of concrete, pictorial and abstract methods. Any practice at home would help us to become quicker and more confident.



English

Our books for this term are written by Julia Donaldson starting with 'The Snail and the Whale'. A whale has suddenly appeared in our outside area and we will be predicting why the whale is here. We



will be learning to adapt a story, write a prediction and write a postcard. We will be using skills such as applying adjectives, using capital letters for days of the week, using 'and' to extend our sentences, and using question marks.

Science

Why do we not wear shorts in the Winter?

In Science we will be looking at Seasonal Changes. We will be recording the weather and studying the changes in the length of the day, during the different seasons. We will be focusing on how the season affect the weather and the clothes we wear.
