Dear Families of Nine Acres Primary School,

What a tremendous start back to our 2021/22 academic year! Thank you so much for all your Ofste support in preparing children for their return. This includes taking some time to help them complete any summer learning challenges, naming their new school uniform, supporting bedtime and morning routines and helping the children to 'Strive for Excellence' in all they do.



A warm WELCOME to our new EYFS children and their families! The children have settled into their school life with fantastic energy and a thirst for learning, knowledge and adventure. What an incredible group of children and we are very lucky to have been the chosen school for your little one. Thank you!

As I shared in my last newsletter from Summer Term, our focus for our school development 2021/2022 this academic year is:

- Developing Pupil's Voice and help them use the Language of Learning. ٠
- A focus on Greater Depth writing supporting children to really develop their writer's voice and to write at length.
- Developing the wider curriculum learning for our children with a specific focus on; Science. History, Geography, PSHE, Religious Education and Languages.
- Improving pupils' spelling enabling them to write with clarity.

As you are aware the Government has lifted restrictions related to Covid 19. At Nine Acres Primary, we have chosen a more cautious approach in order to help keep staff and your children as safe as possible whilst the Isle of Wight remains so busy especially with the up and coming IOW Festival due to take place. Children are now learning in Year groups bubbles, staff are asked to wear masks/face shields when in communal areas and maintain social distance between colleagues outside their bubble as well as continuing twice weekly LFT tests. In addition, we have maintained the increased hand washing routines with the children and also our own cleaning regime in school.

Although this may seem cautious at present we are able to provide the children with their full curriculum entitlement whilst also maintaining routines in school. In fact it was a joy to see Year 1 off on their 'Around the Island' trip, Year 4 take part in forest schools with Geoff, Year 3 enjoy their lessons of Ukuleles and Year 5 take part in Science Investigations. We have many more educational visits, visitors and experiences all lined up for the children to enhance their love of learning.

We will be reviewing our Covid 19 procedures towards the end of this half term as well as reviewing school meal provision, possibly moving back to the hall and a wider menu choice when it is safer to do so. This is however all dependent on the national, local and Government picture at this time and I will ensure that families are kept up to date.

You may have noticed that we have not issued the children with a traditional 'Reading Record' this year. We will be moving to a virtual platform for recording reading. Shortly, we will be launching the GoRead Parent App and share how you will be able to record your child's weekly reading through the use of the app on a mobile or tablet. This should then be much easier for families. It is very exciting to be moving forwards on this into the new world of technology! more updates coming soon!

Finally, I would like to thank the whole Nine Acres Staffing Team including Louise our School Cook from Chartwells for their dedication and care of the children and one another. Whenever we start a new academic year there is always an enormous amount of preparation, discussion and thought into making it the best possible year for the children. Thank you!



Reading at Home


It is an expectation that all children in Years EYFS -Year 6 should be reading at home at least 3 times a week.
