
#EXCELLENCE2020

Dear Families,

A wonderful start back to Autumn Term 2! You have been so creative over the half term break - we have had designs of Roman artefacts, stone age facts in Year 3, as well as large constructions of castles to include the Motte and Bailey! The children are thoroughly becoming absorbed in their subjects - please do ask them about their learning at home.

We have been busy reviewing the latest guidance from the Government's plance announcement as we head into Lockdown number 2. We have made some slight changes across school but the main aim is that all schools remain open and all children are expected to attend as we have been doing for some time now. I know this is a very anxious time for families especially around health but also employment. Please do come and speak to us if you need any support.

You will recall that we sent out a consultation to families for our new Relationship, Sex, Health and Education Policy (RSHE) before half term and I am able to share the feedback. We had the following suggestions:



My view regarding sex education is not appropriate until at least the age of 9.

Schools response:

Sex education is not taught until Year 6 - aged 10-11 years and we will send out a letter to families letting them know when this is taught and details of the content so you are fully informed.

Parent question/points raised:

As an adoptive parent I would hope that some discussion is had about some children not living with biological parents. The most important subject area for primary school aged children should focus on is sexual abuse, in terms of what is safe and 'right' in terms of relationships. I would hope that this would highlight to children about what is or is not acceptable, and how they can raise the alarm should they feel something is wrong.

Schools response:

This will be something discussed with the children when we talk about different relationships and different family make ups. We use the PANTS programme from the NSPCC with the children from EYFS upwards to support the children in knowing their bodies and their rights.

Thank you for your feedback, we have now reviewed this, adapted the policy and the RSHE Policy has been approved by the Governing Body. This will now appear on our school website should you wish to revisit any aspect of it. As with any policy in school a regular review will take place by leaders and the Governing Body.

On another note of parental support, our Parents' Evening will be running differently this year as we work around the restrictions placed on us. You will be sent a letter in the next couple of weeks with an appointment time in which your child's class teacher will call you to discuss your child's learning. We know this is not ideal as we do love talking to you face to face and sharing the children's books but we also have a duty to keep you and our staff safe at these pressing times. Do please try to keep the appointment so we can share the wonderful progress your child has made and to talk about things that can support them from home.

A few families have asked me about the Flu vaccination. Thank you for your patience with this as there is a significant amount of organisation that surrounds this process. If you wish your child to have the flu vaccination a letter is being sent home on 9th November. The administration of the vaccination is set to be on the 18th November.

Finally, you will be reassured to know that our sale of poppies will still be going ahead this year. We have always supported the Royal British Legion especially as we hold the veterans who have supported us and our children closely in our Nine Acres Family. Please see the poppy box on this newsletter for your child's classes sale day.
