A reminder that all children should be reading at least 3 times a week and this is recorded on our 'Go Read App'. We do still have a few families who have not accessed this app so please pop into the office to let us help you get set up. We all know that if a child can read fluently, understand what they have read and enjoy reading this skill is a life changer! Please continue to help us help your child by listening to them read at home.

You may see that we will be advertising for a 'Family Liaison Officer' to join the Nine Acres Team as Mrs Hussey will be going off on maternity leave at the end of this half term. We know what a valued support she is to our community so we want to get the right person to fill in and provide this ongoing support. Hall Hire


