Dear Families of Nine Acres,

Wow! How wonderful to have our Year 5 pupils back to school! I'm so proud of them all! We really are beginning to feel just like our unique school again. Everyone will have received a letter now regarding your child's return to school before the Summer Holidays, if you have not received this please do contact the office to check we have the right contact details for you and we will happily run through any questions you may have.

You may have seen lots more media speculation surrounding schools return in September. We are already having discussions here at Nine Acres to ensure we are able to receive as many pupils back as possible given the Government guidelines. However, we need to wait until they send us an update before we can share anything further as things do keep changing! I hope to update you as soon as possible.

One thing we do ask is that now pupils are returning to school we do expect them in everyday we are open to them. We have worked tirelessly to make this happen for all our families as well as the dedicated staffing team who are planning and delivering formal lessons, it is vital the children are in everyday. Some parents have been taking their children out for different events or a day out because they aren't working and it's sunny however this means that your child is missing another day of their education and causes extra work when they return trying to catch them up....again!

I would like to remind families that this is still school time and there will be plenty of time to spend together in the summer holidays. The school office will call you to ask why your child is absent from school as our normal procedures.

Back at school it is business as usual as the children are enjoying the routine. We are also really excited to hold our EYFS sports day on Thursday 9th July. Sadly, we are not able to invite families at this time to join us but we will post lots of photos for you to see. I hope you understand that we must ensure the safety of pupils and families at this time. Please can you ensure your child comes to school in their PE kit on this day, hat, water bottle and sun cream applied. For the very small number of EYFS pupils remaining at home a virtual sports day will be created for your child to take part.

I've been delighted to receive phone calls from families who have heard about Nine Acres and want to join us from across all year groups. Max in Year 4 had his picture taken outside the house. Thank you for spreading the word - this means we now have a waiting list for current EYFS and Year 4!

Next week we are very much looking forward to the return of our Year 2 pupils who will join us everyday. Please make sure you re-read the letter to know what your child needs and the different starting and finishing times. We can't wait to see them and hear about their learning at home.


