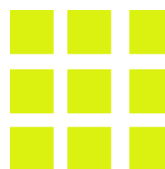

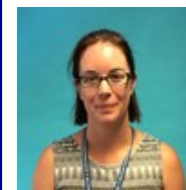

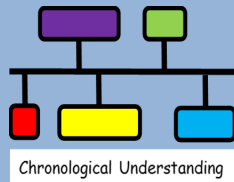


Year 1 - Autumn Term 2 2021 - How many ways can you send a message?

Important facts to know by the end of this topic:

- Alexander Graham Bell invented the telephone.
- One of the first public telephone boxes was used. This was called K1 and can be found in Bembridge on the Isle of Wight!
- In 1985, the first mobile phone for personal use was used in the UK.
- Telephones in the past were not as small as we have today and many children your age did not have a mobile phone.

New - produced, introduced, or discovered recently or now for the first time; not existing before.

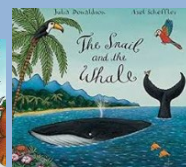
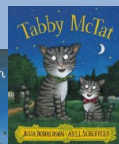
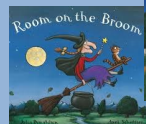
Past - gone by in time and no longer existing.
