
Year 6 - Autumn Term 1 2017 - Theme: Rivers & Mexico

English - Holes

We have started this year with a short unit looking at Formal letter writing. The children are investigating their dream job and over a unit focussed on developing text and sentence structure, they will create letters of application for their chosen career.

We are going to start our English learning this year looking at Louis Sachar's fantastic text 'Holes'. The children will follow

the character Stanley Yelnats through his struggles and triumphs at 'Camp Green Lake'. We will be writing a variety of texts non—fiction explanations inspired by the ominous sounding 'Yellow-spotted lizards', persuasive writing around 'Camp Green Lake' and they will investigate flashback techniques through their own poetry and fiction.



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Maths

We have started this year looking at some fundamental maths skills with place value and the four operations. We will developing the children's fluency as well as allowing to then practise their skills through a range of problem solving and reasoning tasks.

Science

Our science topic this term is called 'Animals including humans'. As part of this unit the children will learn about the circulatory and respiration systems of the human body. They will learn about how to keep their hearts and lungs healthy alongside some hands experiments. This unit links to our famous Year 6 event —

'Are you fitter than a 10 Year old?'
