EYFS Summer Term 2 - Theme: Minibeasts



Personal Social and Emotional Development

Children will be encouraged to talk about their ideas and choose the resources they need. They will be thinking about the consequences of their actions particularly when looking after minibeasts.

Communication and Language

This half term the children will be encouraged to answer how and why questions about their experiences. They will be encouraged to show awareness of listeners' needs and to express their ideas effectively.

Physical Development

This half term we continue to develop our handwriting and will be moving on to look at forming capital letters alongside lower case letters. In PE we will be busy practicing all the different activities ready for sports day.

Literacy

Reading

We will continue to work on applying our sound knowledge when reading words and sentences. The children will be encouraged to talk about what they have read to demonstrate their understanding. We will be having a focus on reading those tricky irregular words.

<u>Writing</u>

Children will be encouraged to write sentences that they and others can read. We will be encouraging them to write at greater length and develop their story writing. We will also focus on writing tricky words.

<u>Mathematics</u>

Number

Children will continue to develop their understanding of number, particularly using their understanding to solve problems. Will be busy counting in 2s, 5s, and 10s.

Shape, Space and Measure

We will be introducing the children to money and the different coin values. We will be revisiting lots of learning that we have done throughout the year to ensure the children are moving into Year 1 with a secure foundation.

Understanding of the World

<u>People and Communities</u> As the children begin to explore moving in to Year 1 we will be encouraged to be sensitive to the needs of their peers.

<u>The World</u>

The children will be busy making observations of different minibeasts and exploring similarities and differences between them.

<u>Technology</u>

We will be introducing the children to some new technology. They will be encouraged to select and use the cameras and microphones for a particular purpose.

Children will be exploring lots of different songs and dances and encouraged to change them to express their own ideas. We will be busy using lots of techniques to paint pictures and make models of different minibeasts.
