

Dear Families,

We have been made aware that many of our children are playing **'Fortnite Battle Royale'** and other games and software that are reportedly being used by children with Nine Acres Primary. Many contain content or social media aspects which are <u>not</u> age appropriate, and represent a real risk to pupils. I would like to remind families that this particular game has an age rating of **12**, due to the: *'frequent scenes of mild violence'*. It is not suitable for persons under **12** years of age'. We know children as young as 5 are accessing this game and therefore acting out what they are witnessing on the playground without truly understanding the consequences on their peers. It has also recently been highlighted in the news that children are being asked and persuaded into inappropriate actions through the chat facility. This has included sexual grooming. I would hate for any of our wonderful pupils to be subject to this and urge parents to check on their child's access rights and activity within these games.

The NSPCC and O2 are offering parents the following advice, in response to the concerns about Fortnite:

- Talk to your child regularly about what they are doing online and how to stay safe. Let them know they can come to you or another trusted adult if they're feeling worried or upset by anything they have seen.
- Explore your child's online activities together. Understand why they like using certain apps, games or websites and make sure they know what they can do to keep themselves safe.
- Agree your own rules as a family when using sites, apps and games.
- Manage your technology and use the privacy and parental control settings available to keep your child safe.

On a more positive note it was wonderful to welcome so many parents from Year 3 (Arundel) who were making a Charlie in the Chocolate Style product and Y3/4 (Alnwick) who took part in their Victorian inspired day. Next week Year 1 are off to the Mayflower Theatre to watch the Beauty and the Beast performance and Year 5 will be performing their Mexican inspired Day of the Dead Dance to the other year groups in preparation for their special Valentines Mexican evening for their families on Thursday 14th February. Year 6 will continue learning their ukuleles and Year 4 with their trumpets on Tuesdays. On Wednesday next week, we will also be welcoming 'Everybody Sing' in to school so we can learn some new songs to sing!

My goodness we are such a busy school! All our activities, trips and visits do offer the children a rich cultural experience. Thank you for your support in helping it all to happen.


