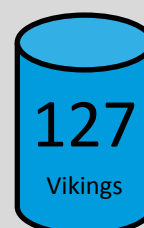
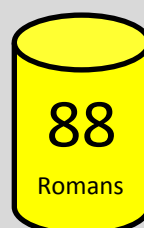
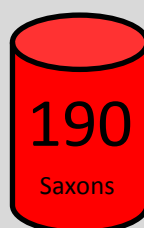


Little Acres Childcare Centre
