Dear Families of Nine Acres,

This week we have emailed you all a letter regarding our plans for introducing EYFS, Y1 and Y6 pupils back to school along with our current provision for our Key Worker families. This plan was set out by the Government and is yet to be confirmed as going ahead until the 28th May when a final decision will be made by them. If you haven't received a copy do please email us or text us. Paper copies are available at the office if you need one.

I know across the country there has been wide spread discussions and debates about opening schools up to the wider school population. I'm sure these will also be happening in your home. At Nine Acres, we have read the latest Government guidance, looked at other practice internationally, taken advice from unions and the Local Authority and thought through as many practical strategies to keep your child and our team as safe as possible but like anything I cannot make promises or assurances. We have looked closely at plans to minimise risk to both adults and pupils on site and these are included in the letter.

If you do have any questions or queries, I urge you to get in direct contact with us and not make conclusions from any other source such as social media. We will be able to answer you clearly and with the correct information, so you can make an informed choice.

I would like to say that as you would expect the Nine Acres staffing team have been exceptional in their planning for moving forward. Their professionalism and commitment has been very humbling. They really do have your children in their hearts and minds.

It is half term now! We will be open Tuesday to Friday for our key worker families so they can continue their crucial role in our community. For others please enjoy the beautiful weather and relax knowing that we are here to help if you need us.

Cookery Section EASY PANCAKES

Ingredients

100g plain flour 2 large eggs 300ml milk 1 tbsp sunflower or vegetable oil, plus a little extra for frying lemon wedges, to serve (optional) caster sugar, to serve (optional)

Method

1. Put 100g plain flour, 2 large eggs, 300ml milk, 1 tbsp sunflower or vegetable oil and a pinch of salt into a bowl or large jug, then whisk to a smooth batter.

2. Set aside for 30 mins to rest if you have time, or start cooking straight away.

3. Set a medium frying pan or crêpe pan over a medium heat and carefully wipe it with some oiled kitchen paper.

When hot, cook your 4. pancakes for 1 min on each side until golden, keeping them warm in a low oven as you go.



5. Serve with lemon wedges and caster sugar, or your favourite filling.




ANIMAL WELFARE UPDATES
