Year 3 - Summer Term 2 2017 - Theme: Mighty Metals

Computing

Use software and internet services to collect, evaluate and present information in a range of different ways. Understand opportunities computer networks and the internet have to offer which enable communication and collaboration.

Mathematics

Angles: Identify horizontal and vertical lines, including parallel and perpendicular lines. Recognise right angles as a property of shape and turns.

Addition and subtraction through measures: Use compact column method to add and subtract 2 digit numbers with exchanging. Solve addition and subtraction problems in different contexts including missing numbers problems.

Add and subtract amounts of money: Use a number line to add and subtract 3 digit numbers. Use a number line to find the difference. Add and subtract decimals to 2 decimal places in the context of money.

Measure the perimeter of 2D shapes.

Multiplication: Use grid method to multiply 2-digit numbers by 1 digit. Divide 2-digit numbers by 1 digit. Solve problems involving multiplication and division.

Fractions: solving problems.

R.E

Exploring the importance of ritual and prayer in Christianity and Judaism. Thinking about personal responses to ritual and the themes raised.

PSHE

Exploring the world of work. Identifying different jobs, personal ambitions and skills required.





Theme

This term in Mighty Metals we will be meeting Andy Aluminium and Sam Steel. We will look at the car manufacturing process, day in the life of a mechanic and how metals are used and recycled. As a local study we will find out about the history of ship building on the Isle

Wight and look at places around the world where ships are sent to be recycled. Finally, we will look at Transformers!



Science

Children will explore the requirements of plants for life and growth and how they vary from plant to plant. They will investigate the way in which water is

transported within plants and explore the part

that flowers play in the life cycle of flowering plants, including pollination, seed formation and seed dispersal.



English

In English, Year 3 will be continuing to study 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. We will be writing newspaper reports about the Space—Angle—Bat—Dragon invading Australia before we move



on to instructions of how to put the Iron Man back together again. Our final piece of writing will be persuading the world about why we should have world peace.

As part of our topic, Mighty Metals, Year 3 will look at the car manufacturing process and the day in the life of a mechanic. As a



local study we will find out about the history of ship building on the Isle of Wight and look at places around the world where ships are sent to be recycled. How Parents/Carers can help at home...

Homework - Maths and English homework will alternate every week

and will be handed out on Wednesdays and collected in on Mondays.

PE - Kits are needed in school on Wednesdays.
