

Next week in school is Assessment Week for children in Years 1 to 6. These will take place in school and face to face because we know how much you value being in school and seeing the children's learning for yourselves. 
In the mornings, we know that the weather can be a challenge! The doors for KS2 will open at 8:30am (children in KS2 should not arrive at school before 8:25am) and if there is heavy rain also in KS1 at 8:30am. We ask that all the children come prepared for wet weather in the mornings as if it is light rain the children will still remain on the playground for their 8:45am start in KS1. This is because we need to ensure staff are there to supervise the children in the classrooms and know who has entered the building for fire safety reasons. A reminder that parents should not go to the classroom doors to speak to the adults as they are busy settling the children in the morning. This includes if you are late, children are able to make their way to their classroom and can be overseen from the playground. If you need to pass on information please speak to the teacher on the playground when collecting the children or go to the main office. Our staffing team is dedicated to ensuring the best possible start everyday for your child, please work with us to ensure all children feel well supported.

If you have managed to secure tickets for the Halloween Disco then I look forward to seeing you there! Adults and children are welcome to dress up and enjoy the fun occasion. Thank you to those adults and staff who have volunteered to help, without you we couldn't even begin to put on these events. We know some families have missed out this year on a ticket due to restricted numbers for health and safety reasons so we are liaising with the Helping Hands Team (who are also volunteers!) to see what we can adapt for next year's festivities so more people can enjoy the celebrations at Nine Acres.




