Re. Attendance

It's really great to see the children nicely settled and ready for their learning each day.

In order to continue this fantastic start and to ensure that no learning time is lost, we wanted to take this opportunity to explain how the morning routine needs to run now our children are in full time.

8.45am – EYFS doors are open and children are greeted by a member of the EYFS team. Parents are also welcome to join the children in the unit. Children do not need to line up on the playground.

8.55am – EYFS doors will close. Parents need to ensure that they have left the unit by this time.

Arriving after 8.55am – children and parents will need to go to the main office and the children will be taken down to the classroom by our friendly office staff. Children will not be marked in late until after 9.00am.

Attendance and punctuality are vitally important here at Nine Acres. We have found that in order for our children to be happy confident learners, having the same routine everyday allows for their independence to grow, which will have a huge impact on their education and beyond. This also means that they are not distracted by people coming in and out of the classrooms and can get straight into their learning.
