We are able to provide this trip at the cost of £24.50 per child which will need to be paid by 7<sup>th</sup> October 2019 via ParentPay. As it is linked to our curriculum, we would very much like for all of the class to be able to join us so please speak to us if you have any questions or concerns.

Further details will be provided as it gets nearer but as the weather can be unpredictable, they will all need a waterproof coat. All children will also require a packed lunch.
