



# Pupil Leadership Mental Health Discussions

Our Pupil Leadership team has led a classroom discussion all about looking after our mental health. The pupil leaders asked the question - How can you look after your own mental health and the following four options were discussed:

Talk about the way you feel Find a hobby or something you enjoy

Look after yourself by getting fresh air, enough sleep and a healthy diet Spend time with people you like and share a positive experience

Children were given time to discuss these and then fed back to their class pupil leaders. A vote then took place where children decided which one would be the most beneficial.

67% of the children of Nine Acres decided that Looking after yourself by getting fresh air, enough sleep and a healthy diet was the best way to look after your mental health.

13% of children said talking about how you feel and finding a hobby.

6% said spending time with people you like.

Children were also asked to comment on why they thought this was the best option, to which they suggested that if you have a healthy body and enjoy things, this will help your mind.

Children were also asked how we could support their mental health in school and they said:

More art lessons / Longer P.E sessions.

More songs through the radio / Cooking lessons

Make a room to resolve arguments by ourselves

A room to chat about worries and a person to give advice about that problem, a person from each class to be a representative with a badge

Sports leaders (from Year 5 and 6) take out a different group of children every break time/ lunch time to have some physical activity.

As a pupil leadership team, we will be discussing these ideas in more depth and will focus on trying to implement some of these new ideas!
