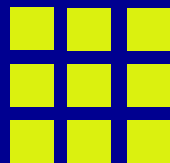

We started the week with a Development Day all about the curriculum. The curriculum is 'the sequence of subjects and experiences that children learn through their journey of education'. We have reviewed what and why we teach what we do for our amazing children of Nine Acres. We have thought very carefully about what the children of Nine Acres bring to the school community and what they will need to be successful learners and citizens of our world today. The staff were buzzing with ideas about the themes and topics to be taught along with lots of trips and visits experiences to bring the learning to life for next year... watch this space how you will be a key part in this development!

'Striving for Excellence'

On Wednesday a team of Year 4 pupils attended the *FIRST*® LEGO® League Expo at Ryde School. The *FIRST*® LEGO® League is a global STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) challenge for teams of young people, to encourage an interest in real world themes and develop key skills that are crucial for their future careers. This was the first of its kind on the Island and the children had an amazing time creating their Mission Moon.

At 3:15pm staff will be available in their new classrooms to meet you so you can put a face to a name and share anything you feel important at this stage. 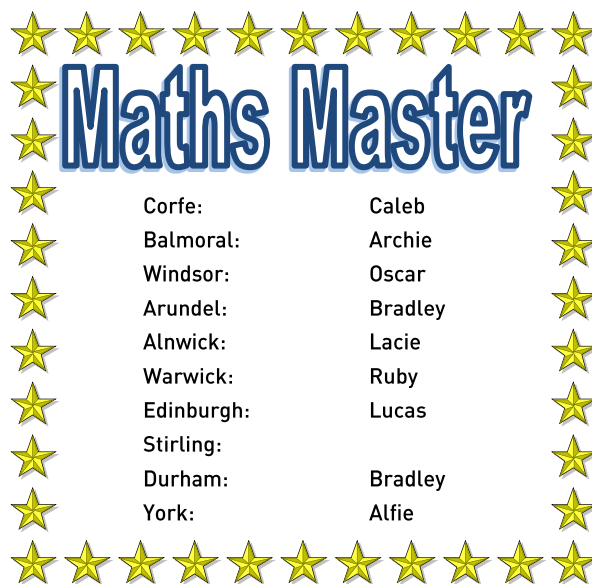

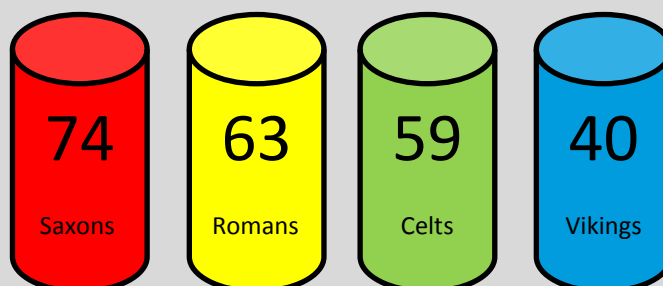

HEADLICE

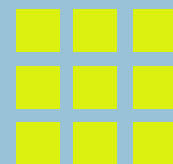
