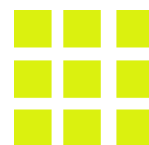

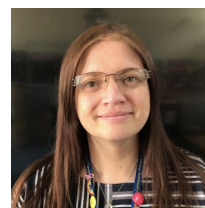

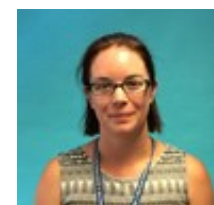

Science

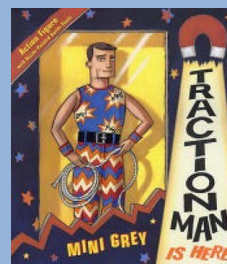
What is the best material for an umbrella or a bucket? We will be finding out by learning all about materials and their uses. This will involve us sorting a range of materials into groups and experimenting with their uses.

Materials

English

Our class book is Traction Man by Mini Grey. We will be producing lots of exciting villain descriptions, a recount of our traction man adventure and learning to use adjectives and expanded noun phrases when creating interesting setting descriptions.



How can you help at home?

Mathematics

In Maths we will be learning all about place value, addition and subtraction. We will use these skills to help us find answers to problems and will be practicing our reasoning skills by explaining our answers and thinking about why things happen in a logical way!

Our theme in Year 2 is going to be about Rubbish!

This term, we will be learning all about Rubbish in our local environment and globally. We will be exploring through our 6 key questions: Where do we find rubbish?; Can everything be recycled? How has packaging changed over time?; What is the impact of rubbish?; and how do we reduce the amount of rubbish?

We hope by the end of this half term we will understand their responsibilities in looking after our environment and the importance of recycling.
