House Points Winners

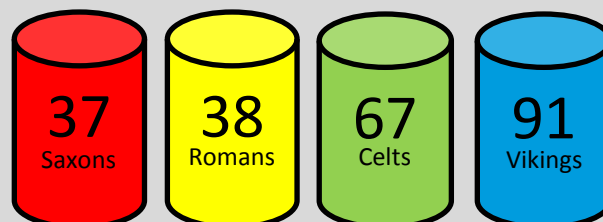
Well done to Vikings who have gained the most house points this term. To celebrate there will be a mufti day for Vikings House on **Thursday 13th February 2020.**

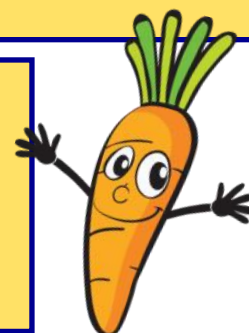
