Dear Families of Nine Acres,

Another busy week at Nine Acres with a large percentage of pupils back in school in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 6. It has been wonderful to see their smiling faces and for the teachers to begin to restore any learning gaps created by the lockdown. We are now formally back to teaching the curriculum and are amazed already at the progress the children have made especially with their writing. This is all credit to their attitude to their studies and ability to regain their confidence in learning. What wonderful pupils we have at Nine Acres and thank you to all the families for their support during a challenging time.

A reminder to those families with pupils at home new weekly learning packs will be emailed to you (a paper copy can be made available if you contact the office) for Years 2,3,4. We have also provided paper learning packs for the children not in school in EYFS, Year 1, Year 5 and Year 6. It is vital that these are collected so your child can continue their education. We do have a place allocated especially for them! If you are concerned or have any questions about the procedures we have put in place you are very welcome to pop in for a visit to see us in action for yourselves and we can chat through anything worrying you.

On this note, you may have heard the latest Government announcement that it is up to individual schools how we manage the return of any other year groups before the summer holidays or after September. I am delighted that at Nine Acres we have formulated a plan to support further year groups return before the summer holidays keeping in mind the strict Government protocols regarding social distancing and cleaning procedures. We have had to think outside the box a little so please bare with us but feel it is important that every child has an opportunity to return to school before the summer holidays to meet their new teacher and receive some formal education. I will be writing to individual year group families to inform you of the plans moving forward and forthcoming dates for return. Look out for your child's opportunity to rejoin us!

We have also established plans that means each year group will move up to their new teacher from 6th July. We know that the children really benefit from this and so do the teachers in getting to know them ready for September. Whether in school or at home you will be notified of your child's new teacher on this day and I will be sharing the staffing team with you in the next newsletter now it is confirmed.

On Monday, we will be holding a development day and the school is closed to all pupils. The staffing team will be in school discussing your children with the new teacher and sharing your child's individual learning strategies as well as planning the curriculum for them from the 6th July. The team are very excited to get started on this and already have many thoughts and ideas to support your children. We are so lucky to have such a dedicated team here and I cannot praise the team highly enough for all they are doing at this time.

As always the children are at the heart of everything we do here. Their well-being and education are at the forefront of all our plans.

Some of you, I'm sure, will be missing the buzz of the isle of Wight Festival this weekend. It's such a big event on the island! So why not have your own family festival! Enjoy some music, dancing, dressing up, create your own band, wear your wellies and relax in the sunshine (or rain!). We would love to see any photos of home made festivals!


