### Science

Following the success of our Christmas decorations, the children will be continuing to learn about electricity. They will be exploring electrical circuits and learning about the components and conductors.

### **English**

Within English this half term, we are focussing our studies around

Libby Hathorn's text 'Way Home'. The children have already begun to explore the emotive illustrations from the text and have begun to develop their descriptive writing skills in order to write a powerful story opener. Other writing opportunities will include a newspaper report and an extended retelling of the story.



### PE

In our PF lessons we will continue to be playing invasion games such as rugby and football. Please ensure your child has their kit on Monday and Thursday.

### Mathematics

As of this term, we will be trialling new Maths groups which should help us to tailor your child's learning experience even further. Topics will include, fractions, algebra, data handling and ratio and proportion.



### Theme



Tying in with our book, the theme of Gallery Rebels explores a variety of modern arts and considers the question of whether or not graffiti is a form of modern art.

The focus of this term will begin with Homelessness, linking to our text 'Way Home'. We have an exciting outcome for this topic which will give the children the opportunity to gain an insight to what it is like to be homeless. Dates and more information will follow soon.



### Computing

In Computing, the children will be developing their confidence using the Microsoft Office suite of programs with tasks such as creating a holiday brochure. We will also be continuing the children's learning of programming.

During the first half term, the children will study an introduction to Islam, with a focus on community. In the second half term, the children will explore the story of Jesus' resurrection leading up to the Christian celebration of Easter.
