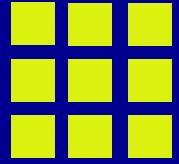

Dear Families,

Welcome back to the Summer Term! It's a busy term with class assemblies, sports days and move up days. Please keep an eye out for letters home, text messages and newsletter updates.

It is also a very important term for our Y1 children who will be taking their Government Phonics Tests, our Y2 children who will be taking their KS1 Government tests in Reading, Spelling, Grammar and Punctuation as well as Mathematics and finally our Y6 pupils who will also be taking their Government KS2 SATs tests the week beginning **Monday 13th May**. The children have all been working incredibly hard both in school and at home. We have told the children that this is their time to shine and show off all they know!

To enable every child to have an opportunity to demonstrate what they can do in the tests some children will have different 'access arrangements' in agreement with the Standards and Testing Agency (STA). This may mean that they are in a separate room, supported by an adult reading, use a scribe or are allocated additional time to complete the test. As always we will do what is best for your child within the strict regulations that we are expected to adhere to by the Government.

You can help your child by making sure they have a good night's sleep before each day and a filling breakfast to keep them going. We will be providing a *free breakfast* (bacon sandwiches!) for our Y6 pupils every morning of their test week just to top them up. It is vital that we also keep on top of our attendance and all children are in school on time so they don't miss out on taking these important tests.

It is only the second week back and already Y1 have been on a trip to Marwell Zoo. They had a wonderful time seeing *real* animals! Thank you to all the staff who made this possible and I know this will inspire the children in their learning.

Miss Barton has introduced the idea of debating to the children in assembly on Friday. Next half term we will be holding weekly debates in class and then whole school debates in assembly we have introduced some key sentence starters for the children to help structure what they want say and how to respond to someone. I have attached these to the newsletter - maybe you could try using these at home to prepare them for holding their own topical debate!

I hope to see you all at the May Fayre. Thank you to the Helping Hands Team for all their time and effort in organising our Community event. All monies raised will go towards the children of Nine Acres!

need to wear a verruca sock and children with long hair should have it tied

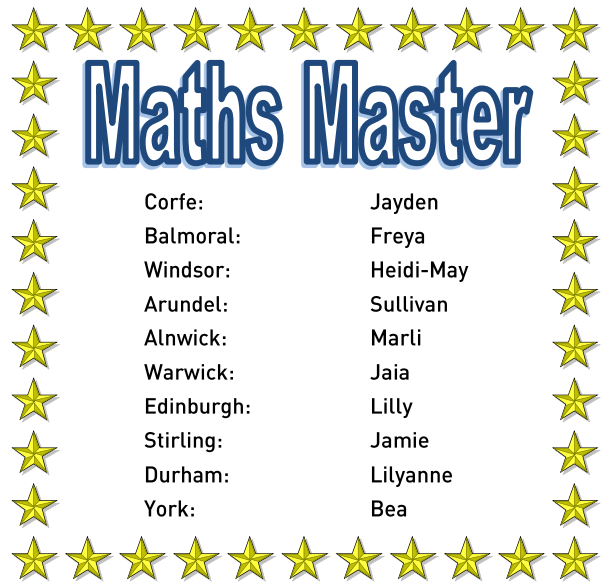

For a fish in a golden dish.

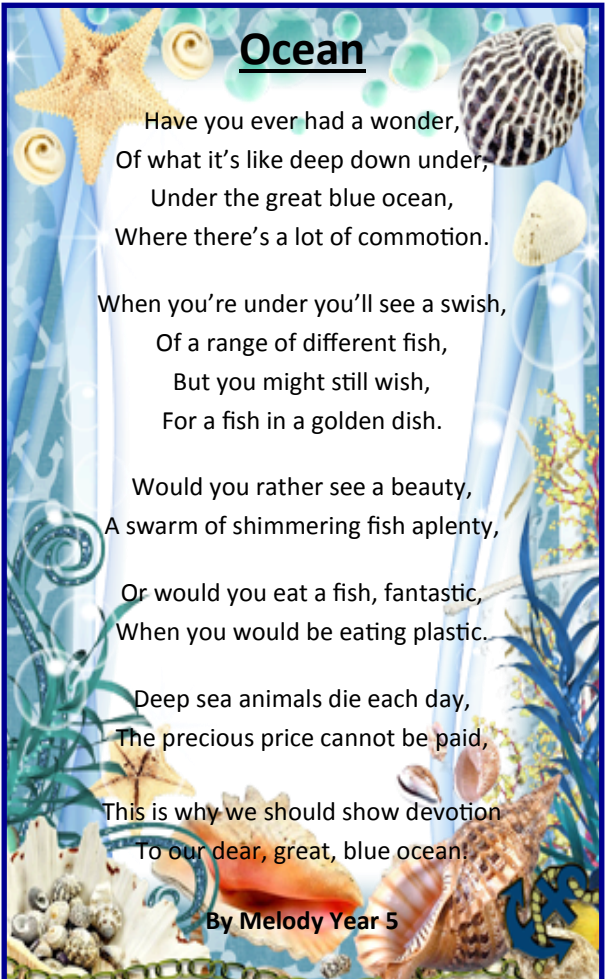
Would you rather see a beauty,

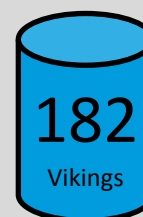

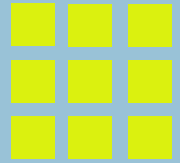
