# (Outdoor Adventurous Activities)

On Monday and Tuesday of this week, Year 5 travelled to Wales for their Alex Ryder residential. In the heart of the Wye Valley, they took part in outdoor activities that tested their teamwork capabilities, communication skills and ability to problem-solve.

On their 5-mile walk, with 240m elevation, children orienteered themselves away from the base and back again, making note of natural markers such as the Wye River and man-made indicators such as roads and bridges.
