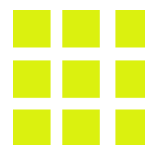

Within PE we will be developing our 'team games' skills through different sports such as rounders and scatter ball. We will also be working on our athletic skills in preparation for our Sports Day.



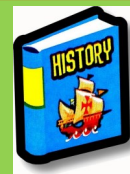
## Mathematics
